

Testing of Faith NAS

James 1.2-4

Consider it all joy, my brethren, when you encounter various trials, knowing that the testing of your faith produces endurance. And let endurance have *its* perfect result, so that you may be perfect and complete, lacking in nothing.

Testing of Faith NAS

1 Peter 1.6-7

In this you greatly rejoice, even though now for a little while, if necessary, you have been distressed by various trials, so that the proof of your faith, *being* more precious than gold which is perishable, even though tested by fire, may be found to result in praise and glory and honor at the revelation of Jesus Christ;

Results of Unbelief NAS

Hebrews 4.2

For indeed we have had good news preached to us, just as they also; but the word they heard did not profit them, because it was not united by faith in those who heard.

Results of Unbelief NAS

Hebrews 10.38

But my righteous one shall live by faith; and if he shrinks back, my soul has no pleasure in him.

(4) Faith Hebrews 10.38

Source of Faith NAS

Romans 10.17

So faith *comes* from hearing, and hearing by the word of Christ.

(5) Faith Romans 10.17

Source of Faith NAS

Hebrews 11.1

Now faith is the assurance of *things* hoped for, the conviction of things not seen.

(6) Faith Hebrews 11.1

Faith in Action NAS

Galatians 5.6

For in Christ Jesus neither circumcision nor uncircumcision means anything, but faith working through love.

(7) Faith Galatians 5.6

Faith in Action NAS

James 2.17

Even so faith, if it has no works, is dead, *being* by itself.

(8) Faith James 2.17

Justified by Faith NAS

Romans 5.1

Therefore, having been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ.

Justified by Faith NAS

James 2.23

And the Scripture was fulfilled which says, "And Abraham believed God, and it was reckoned to him as righteousness," and he was called the friend of God.
