Matthew 6.24

“No one can serve two masters; for either he will hate the one and love the other, or he will be devoted to one and despise the other. You cannot serve God and wealth.”

Contentment NAS
1 Timothy 6.6-8

But godliness *actually* is a means of great gain when accompanied by contentment. For we have brought nothing into the world, so we cannot take anything out of it either. If we have food and covering, with these we shall be content.

Proverbs 23.4

Do not weary yourself to gain wealth, Cease from your consideration *of it*.

Proverbs 11.24-25

There is one who scatters, and *yet* increases all the more, And there is one who withholds what is justly due, *and yet it results* only in want. The generous man will be prosperous, And he who waters will himself be watered.

The Test of Wealth NAS
Proverbs 16.16

How much better it is to get wisdom than gold! And to get understanding is to be chosen above silver.

Two Masters NAS
1 Timothy 6.9-10

But those who want to get rich fall into temptation and a snare and many foolish and harmful desires which plunge men into ruin and destruction. For the love of money is a root of all sorts of evil, and some by longing for it have wandered away from the faith and pierced themselves with many griefs.

Contentment NAS
Hebrews 13.5-6

Make sure that your character is free from the love of money, being content with what you have; for He Himself has said, “I will never desert you, nor will I ever forsake you,” so that we confidently say, “The Lord is my helper, I will not be afraid. What will man do to me?”

The Trap of Wealth NAS
Ecclesiastes 5.10

He who loves money will not be satisfied with money, nor he who loves abundance *with its* income. This too is vanity.

Giving NAS
Luke 6.38

“Give, and it will be given to you. They will pour into your lap a good measure--pressed down, shaken together, *and* running over. For by your standard of measure it will be measured to you in return.”

The Test of Wealth NAS
Luke 16.10-11

“He who is faithful in a very little thing is faithful also in much; and he who is unrighteous in a very little thing is unrighteous also in much. Therefore if you have not been faithful in the *use of* unrighteous wealth, who will entrust the true *riches* to you?”
