The Objective of Discipleship

Matthew 10.24–25

“A *disciple* is not above his *teacher*, nor a *slave* above his *master*. It is enough for the disciple that he become like his teacher, and the slave like his master.”

What is a disciple?

A disciple is someone who has *submitted* their life to Jesus as their **Teacher** and is living a life of devotion to him.

A disciple is someone who has *surrendered* their life to Jesus as their **Master** and is living a life of obedience to him.
